**SOCIETY ACT
CONSTITUTION**

1. The name of the society is: Canadian Professional Association for Transgender Health
2. The purposes of the society are:
 - a) The Canadian Professional Association for Transgender Health is a professional organization devoted to the health care of individuals with gender variant identities.
 - b) As an interdisciplinary, professional organization, the Canadian Professional Association for Transgender Health will further the understanding and health care of individuals with gender variant identities by professionals in medicine, psychology, law, social work, counselling, psychotherapy, family studies, sociology, anthropology, sexology, speech and voice therapy, and other related fields.

BYLAWS

The bylaws of the Canadian Professional Association for Transgender Health are those set out in Schedule B to the *Society Act*, with the following variations, deletions and additions:

1. Bylaw 25(1) of Part 5 – delete vice-president and add past president and president elect positions to the directorship of the society.
2. Bylaw 31(3) of Part 6 – delete vice-president and add past president.
3. Bylaw 41 of Part 7 – delete vice-president and add past president.
