

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

CPATH Community of Practice Coordinator (Part-time contract)

Expressions of interest are invited from qualified individuals to coordinate a nation-wide Community of Practice (CoP) initiative of the Canadian Professional Association for Transgender Health (CPATH), for a part-time contract.

CPATH is an interdisciplinary professional organization which works to improve the lives of trans and gender diverse people. CPATH seeks to be both connected with and responsive to the needs emerging from trans people and communities.

CPATH's CoP initiative aims to develop and maintain a community of health care providers and other professionals who work with trans people across Canada. The Coordinator will:

- 1) support a collaborative learning initiative,
- 2) facilitate communication between CPATH / CoP Members,
- 3) promote standards and promising practices in working with trans and gender diverse people and communities,
- 4) deliver general project coordination and support, and
- 5) provide a sustainability plan for continuation of the CoP.

The Coordinator has experience and background in adult learning, health, and community development and is well versed in the theory and practice of how communities of practice function. The individual has a solid understanding of issues facing trans and gender diverse communities, and the needs of professionals who work with them. The coordinator will be working on a 10 month part-time contract (average of 7-10 hrs/week) for a grant-funded project that may develop into a longer term opportunity, based on performance and future funding.

Required Skills and Knowledge

- Competency and respect for the evolving understanding of gender identity, population health issues, and barriers to health and care, for trans and gender diverse people;
- Excellent group facilitation and meeting coordination skills;
- Competency with project design, monitoring, reporting and evaluation;
- Excellent English Language oral and written communications skills;
- Preference for strong French Language skills; and
- The ability to work with tight deadlines.
